### **Extra-Mural Activities**

The students are given ample opportunities to showcase their hidden talent through various extra-curricular activities organized by the college and university. Each year, the budding artists are given a chance to participate in Zonal Youth Festival in which different items like Dance, Group Song, Poem Writing, Recitation, Debate, Elocution, Quiz, Giddha, Chikku Making, Crochet Work, Knitting, Collage Making, Still Life, Clay Modelling, Peeri Making, On the Spot Painting, Ladies Traditional Song are organized. Our College bagged 10 first prizes, 11 second prizes and 18 third prizes in Zonal Youth Festival. These amateurs were given an opportunity of their lifetime as they faced a large crowd for the first time which raised their confidence level to the pinnacle and encouraged them as never before.

#### Sports

In addition to academics and extra- mural activities a plethora of activities are arranged outside the classroom in the picturesque campus of the college. The Department of Sports arranges Athletic Meet every year to prepare students for different competitions. Different events like Shot put, Races like 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, Long Jump, Chati Race, Sack Race, Slow Cycling, and Lemon Race are organized and the students play them in true sportsmanship. During the session 2016-17, our sportspersons brought laurels to the college by winning meritorious positions. 20 athletes of our college participated in Sports and game at the State/ University level. Out of which 14 students brought laurels to the college by winning Medals and awards in State/ University level Competition.

To trim the mental acumen and to equip the faculty with intellectual sharpness, the college publishes an International Journal under the title Vision with ISSN where articles from eminent scholars are invited and published. Three such magazines are already published and the fourth one is in process. The institute also flashes an annual publication of Dharat, which is a compendium of the thoughts of different teachers and students.

The culture of intellect without religion and morality always becomes a big hoax. Knowledge without conscience is but the ruin of the soul of a person. Hence, a sweet blend of the two is required for the harmonious growth of a student. During the session, 28 students were adjudged with "A" Grade in Punjabi People Welfare Association (Regd) on Moral Values. Besides 9 students participated and won laurels for the college in the competition of Dharam Parchaar Committee which was hosted by S.G.P.C. In addition 400 students from different classes comprising of Arts, Commerce, and Science took part in the Holy Sahaj Paath.

During the session 2016-17 the NCC unit of college organized One Day Camp on Swacch Bharat Abhiyan. Tree Plantation, Essay-Writing on the topic "Energy Conservation", Environment Day, Cleanliness Drive in adopted school was organized with fervor. They were followed by lectures delivered on Health and Hygiene Day and General Awareness Day was celebrated. The NSS unit visited the adopted village and organized a medical camp as well as Painting competition among students of the school of that area. Trees were planted not only in the campus but also in the School/Village adopted. Exhibition of Candles and Diyas on occasion of Diwali in collaboration of Asha Kiran Welfare Society (Hoshiarpur) was organized.

Two Annual Training Camps (for 10 days) on Cultural Sports Firing and other activities at NCC Academy Ropar. A Social Awareness Programme on Waste Management was organized by NCC unit. Poster Making and Drawing Competition on the topic "De-addiction, Blood Donation and AIDS prohibition" was also organized in College. Red Ribbon Club of college organized Cartoon Making Competition and seminar on topic HIV, AIDS and Drug Addiction. Oath Ceremony and a Seminar were organized on the "Importance of Right to Vote "by Women Development Cell of the College. A documentary Film was shown on

"Cancer" to PG Classes by Red Ribbon Club of the college. Yoga Day was celebrated on 21 June, 2017.

A composite college and a multi-disciplinary institute, it provides opportunity to students to interact leading to cross-pollination of ideas with merit-based and rigorous selection process. Our students today include the best and the brightest. Besides, to explore this potential and provide them direction, cohesive training programmes like Seminars, Workshops and Symposia are conducted regularly.

The Department of Visual and Performing Art organized "Basant Festival". A National Level Seminar on "Guru Gobind Singh: Jeevan Te Darshan" was hosted by Department of Punjabi. The Literary Quiz competition was conducted by Department of English. "IT FEST" was celebrated by Department of Computer Science. Besides, it also organized an Extension Lecture on "Lifi Technology" for faculty and students on 6 Feb, 2017. An Extension Lecture was organized by Department of Mathematics and Department of Education on Educational Psychology and Teaching Learning process. Annual Art Exhibition was organized by Department of Fine Arts and Fashion Designing. A One Day Workshop on 'Bandish' was conducted by Department of Music (Vocal).

The College not only organizes seminars and exhibitions but it also celebrates the 'Teej' festival, 'Lohri' festival of Punjabis with great zeal and gusto. The enthusiasm of the young participants in these festivals is worth watching.
