Extra-Mural Activities

Our college has attained great academic excellence not only in the field of academics but also it shines brightly in extra-mural and co-curricular activities. To encourage the creativity and talent of the students, the college offers various co-curricular and extra-curricular programmes so that their talent can be chiselled properly. These activities also create multi-cultural awareness and understanding among the students, so that they may develop a sense of global citizenship.

Besides they promote national integration through different cultural activities presented on the stage. This year the college clinched a whopping 52 number of total prizes in the Zonal Youth Festival held at MRPD Govt. College, Talwara. Our artists exhibited a colourful programme winning 22 First prizes, 12 second prizes and 18 third prizes. In Inter Zonal Youth Festival, we bagged Second prize in Histrionics and a Second (Individual) prize in Luddi. We also got a Third prize in Chikhu Making. The students participated in different items like General Dance, Giddha, Bhand Skit, Mime, Mimicry, Debate, Elocution, Poem Writing, Poem Recitation, Story Writing, Collage Making, Peeri Making, Paranda Making, Knitting, Cross stitch, Folk Instrument, Kali, Kavishri, Folk Orchestra, Ladies Traditional Song, On the spot Painting, Quiz, Photography etc.

Sports

In addition to academics and extra-mural activities an abundance of activities are arranged outside the classroom in the picturesque campus of the college. The purpose of such activities is to boost the mental morale of the girls to achieve innate courage and intrinsic ability to face the hurdles and oddities of life with fortitude. To keep the students physically agile and mentally sound, sports plays a pivotal role.

The Department of Sports also arranges Athletic Meet every year to prepare students for different competitions. During the Session 2019-20, our talented sports persons brought laurels to the college by winning meritorious positions in different competitions. Sarikha and Ankita won Bronze medals in 61Kg and 68+ Kg weight categories in Inter College Competition in Karate at Panjab University, Chandigarh. In Inter State Competition in Karate held at Pathankot this year, our girls made us proud by bagging prizes in different Weight Categories. Ekta Rani of B.A 3rd won the Gold medal and Sarikha of B.A 1st won the Silver medal. Shikha Kumari and Reeta Tomar of B.A 3rd won Bronze each. Ankita of B.A 2nd bagged the Bronze medal. Kajal Kumari and Manpreet Kaur of B.A 1st also made us laud their achievements by winning a Bronze each.

The College publishes an International Journal under the title VISION with ISSN No where articles from eminent scholars are published every year. The institute also flashes an annual publication of Dharat, which is a compendium of the thoughts of different teachers and students. In addition, the College also arranges to import moral, intellectual and spiritual discourses to the budding youth so that they may follow the track of righteousness in life. These

discourses are delivered in Morning Assembly or the Ethical Education Exam which is taken up by the students of our college every year and it has become a regular feature of the institute.

During the session 2019-20, 24 cadets attended L.P.U camp at Jalandhar and 12 cadets attended the J.N.V Palahi Camp. 14 cadets were awarded the 'B' certificate and 17 were able to achieve 'C' certificate. Besides this, NCC and NSS wing of our college is regularly involved in Tree Plantation Drives and Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan. They also took out a Drug Abuse Rally in order to enlighten the students and people of the area regarding its ill effects. The NSS unit of the college also took out a Rally against 'Stubble Burning'. The unit educated the farmers against burning of the stubble in their fields and the consequences of it on the environment. This was followed by Slogan Writing Competition and an Extension Lecture on 'Corona virus'. An Annual feature of the College is an Exhibition by AshaKiran Welfare Society to help the needy and the underprivileged children by selling 'Diyas' and Candles.

The session 2019-20 was witness to an inconceivable situation of lockdown due to the spread of COVID-19 pandemic all over the world. But still the zeal and gusto of the students and the teachers could not be hampered due to COVID-19. Our College organized a two day National Webinar on the theme of 'COVID-19: Its Impact on Society'. It was followed by another One Day National Seminar on 'COVID-19 and Indian Economy Issues and Challenges' organized by the PG Department of Commerce and Management.

The Department of English, Hindi and Punjabi came together and organized an Essay and Short Story Writing Competition in order to channelize the creative energy of the students during the pandemic times. The English Department also arranged an Extension Lecture on 'The Poetry of Robert Frost' for which an eminent academician Dr. Amandeep Rana was invited.

Our College always remains at the forefront to conduct various activities, extension lectures or webinars in order to continuously educate, enlighten and develop practical skills of the students. We promise to continue our efforts to maintain the educational standards to enlighten our budding scholars.
