1. INTRODUCTION

Dasmesh Girls College, ChakAlla Baksh, Mukerian was established in 2001 with an aim at emancipatingthe women from the clutches of patriarchal set-upand making them the leaders in the process of development of the nation. It is an unaided institute for Girls permanently affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh in 2006. The college at present has to offer UG and PG courses consisting of B.A, B.A(HONS), B.A(FINEARTS), B.A(FASHION DESIGNING), B.COM, B.B.A, B.C.A, B.SC(N.M), M.A (HIS), M.A(MUV), M.A (HINDI), M.COM , P.G.D.C.A along with the recently inducted B.A B.Ed(4-years integrated course). The college has applied for M.A(Punjabi) and M.A(Pol. Science) in the current session. The college started functioning with only 84 students in the beginning, but now the strength has risen to 1369. Like this it can be easily acknowledged that the college is marching from strength to strength.

The college has been granted the status of 12(B) and 2(f) of the U.G.C. Act, 1956 and is eligible to receive central assistance from various sources other than U.G.C. The institute has established a 'Research Committee' consisting of the faculty members which is responsible for organizing variety of seminars, workshops, extension lectures from time to time. The members of the faculty are also assisted and encouraged in publishing research papers in journals. The college publishes its own International Journal named 'VISION: An International Journal on Humanities and Management under ISSN 2348-3598. Besides, each year college magazine *'Dharat'* is published to develop the writing skills of the students and to bring out their latent talent.

As said earlier, this institution does not receive any grant from any source, including the Government, it is a self-financed college, catering to the needs of the students hailing from the sub-urban areas of the town, especially of those coming from the poor sections of the society. Besides it aims at giving impetus to research work on the various subjects being run by it. The purpose of research creativity refers to the system which involves knowledge of humans, culture and society and the use of this stock of knowledge to devise new applications. The main thrust of introductory research faculty among teachers and students is to make them abreast of the latest technologies and techniquesprevalent in different areas of studies. To fulfill this mission, the college management aims at establishing a chair in the name of the revered Saint Soldier Guru Gobind Singh who fought for liberty, equality & fraternity. The name of the chair will be **Sri Guru Gobind Singh Research Center**. Through this Research Centre the college desires to further spread its wings in the field of research and give opportunities to interested scholars for enhancing their research abilities.

3. ELIGIBILITY:

Research project may be undertaken by an individual teacher or a group of teachers. The financial support would be decided by the Management of the Dasmesh Girls College depending on the project/study. **Principal, Librarianand Physical Education Teacher will also be eligible to participate in the scheme.**

In case a project is undertaken jointly, one of the teachers will function as a Head Scholar and he/she will be responsible for all matters pertaining to the project.

The one, which is offered and accepted firstirrespective of Research Scholar must be completed before the other offer is accepted. Failure to abide by this rule shall make the Research Scholar and the Institution liable to refund the entire amount paid by the Management in all such schemes. They may be also debarred from participation in future programmes. It would be the responsibility of the Research Scholar and the host Institution for total accountability of the project. After completion of one project, if a teacher desires to undertake another Management project, a gap of one year will be necessary. Research Scholar should publish two papers in a reputed journal in the form of Books/Article/Presentation in seminar etc. from the said project completed. Retired teachers, up to the age of 70 years can also participate under the scheme.

In case of retired teachers, there has to be a Co-Investigator (Permanent Teacher) from the Department, where the project is likely to be undertake.

The desirous researchers should choose their topic related to Sri Guru Gobind

Singh only. Their medium of expression can be any of the three languages - English,

Punjabi, Hindi.

4. NATURE OF ASSISTANCE:

Research Project under this Shri Guru Gobind Singh Chair. - Rs. 1 lac to 2 lacs.

The Management will provide financial support for the items like, Books and Journals, Research Personnel ,Hiring Services, Contingency of Research Project.

5. Books and Journals

The Books and Journals acquired by the **Research Scholar**under Research Project must be deposited to College library at the end of the project. They should become institutional property.

6. MODE OF SELECTION

The selection of a candidate as **Research Scholar** \ Project Fellow may be made by an open selection and by a duly constituted Selection Committee. The constitution of the SelectionCommittee will be as under:

- 1 Chairman
- 2 Head of the Institution(Principal)

3 One Subject Expert (External) (from the institute other than the Institute where the project is undertaken.

The **Research Scholar** will have to certify that the all norms have been followed while selecting Project.

7. Tenure

The duration of Research Project under this Chair will be from 12 months to 24 months depending upon the topic of research work and Extension would be permissible only in special circumstances and will be without any financial assistance.

8. Date of Implementation

The effective date of implementation of the project will be the date of receipt of fund by the Institution/Specified by the Commission.

9. PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING

All eligible teachers, working or retired, Principal, Librarian, Director of Physical Education who wish to avail financial assistance for Research Project from The Management of the Dasmesh Girls College should submit their proposal in the prescribed Performa (Annexure – I). The proposal may be sent any time during the year however, the proposal will be evaluated by the Committee twice in a year.

10. PROCEDURE FOR APPROVAL

The proposals received for Research Projects from Various peoplewill be considered by the Expert Committee at Dasmesh Girls College,Mukerian. The final decision will be taken by the Committee keeping in view the recommendations made by the Expert Committee and the availability of funds for the scheme.

11. PROCEDURE FOR RELEASE OF GRANTS

The first installment of the grant shall comprise of 40% at the time of approval of the project. Second installment (30%) shall be released after the 6 months of the project, last and final installment (20%) shall be released after the completion of the project.

12. Submission of Report and Release of Final Grant

The College will nominate one/two subject experts at the time of approval of project for evaluation of final report. The Research Scholar on completion of the project may submit the final report. Experts appointed by the Management of College at the time of approval.

i. A copy of the final report of work done of the project in CD/floppy. Executive summary of the report may be posted on the website of theCollege. This is mandatory condition.

ii. Detailed information about the project in the prescribed Performa (Annexure –VIII).

iii. Month – wise and year – wise detailed statement of expenditure towards salary of staff appointed under the project.

iv. A consolidated item – wise detailed statement of expenditure incurred during the complete project period in the prescribed Performa duly signed by Research Scholars.

The Research Scholars are expected to settle the accounts immediately on completion of the project. In case the grant is not claimed within *six* months from the date of completion of the project, the samewill lapse and no representation will be entertained on this behalf. In case, utilization certificate from statutory auditor is delayed; utilization certificate from Chartered Accountant be submitted within *six* months.
