An Institution in himself, Sant Balbir Singh Seechewal Ji is unquestionably the leading environmentalist, a social activist and a progressive thinker who hails from the village Seechewal, from District Jalandhar in Punjab. He is widely known as the “Eco Baba” who took the initiative to clean and restore the glory of Kali Bein, a tributary of the River Beas in Punjab, which was on the verge of extinction due to high level of domestic and industrial pollution. Sant Seechewal Ji, with the help of his ‘Sangat’ cleared the clogged sewage and waste material from the bed of the river. He restored the flow of clean water in it and beautified it by planting flowering plants, trees, and bricked roads on its banks. Further, he metamorphosed the river side area into a sacred place where a number of people, from India and abroad, come in large numbers to pay homage to its beauty. Dr A.P.J. Abdul Kalam applauded Sant Seechewal Ji’s dedication and work for the restoration of Kali Bein as a “Noble Mission”.

The President of India bestowed on him “Nirmal Gram Puraskar” for his distinguished work as the Sarpanch (Head) of his village, Seechewal. He received the highest Indian civilian award Padma Shree in 2017. Punjab Government felicitated him with the State Award for his charitable service. All India Pingalwara Society also honoured him with “Bhagat Puran Singh Award”. He was hailed as the “Hero of Environment” by a renowned international magazine, *Time*.

Under the aegis of IQAC, SAP and NSS, Dasmesh Girls College invited honourable Sant Balbir Singh Ji Seechewal as the chief spokesperson for an Extension Lecture on 'ਪਹਿਲਾਂ ਪਾਣੀ ਜੀਉ ਹੈ ਜਿਤੁ ਹਰਿਆ ਸਭ ਕੋਇ' which was organized on 28th April, 2022. He enlightened the students and faculty members about the value of environment and natural resources. In his lecture, he emphasised on sustainable development to protect the environment. He highlighted the problem of soil erosion and motivated the students to protect and plant trees in their surrounding areas. Through his soulful words he taught everyone to love and appreciate nature in its plenty.

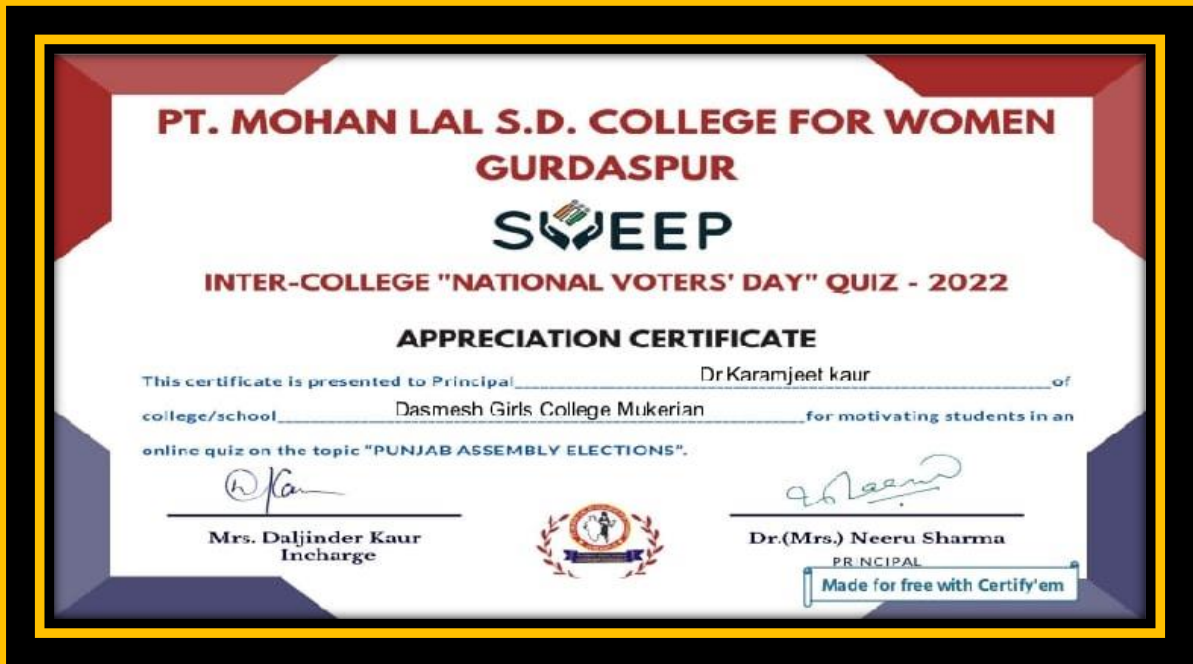

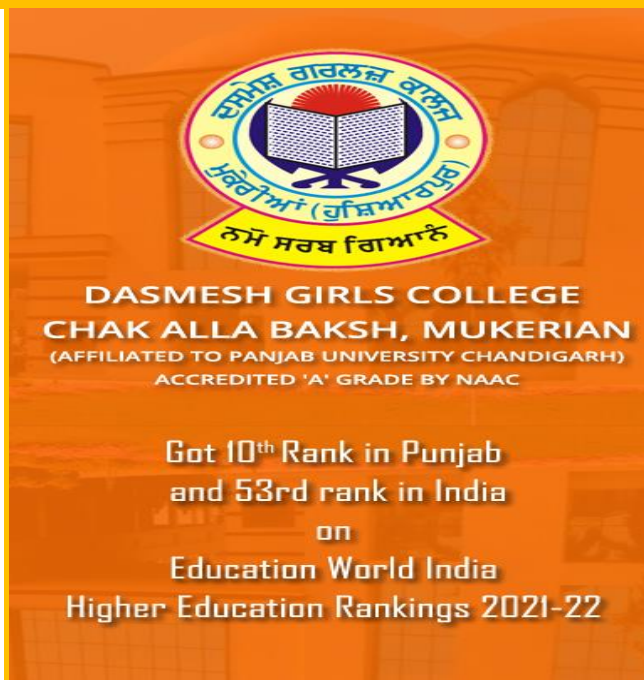

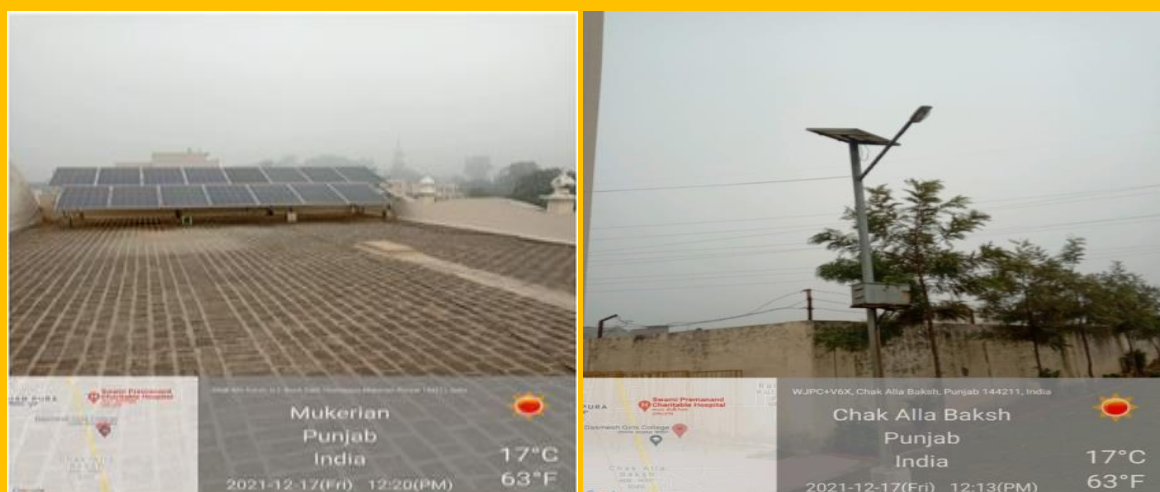

College Library

Bhai Gurdas Library of Dasmesh Girls College is committed to provide excellent academic facilities to the students and faculty members. Library is automated with ILMS software: Bibliosoft; and databases like INFLIBNET, DELNET and OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) are used as research portal facility. The members of the library can access to its database by logging in at www.delnet.nic.in and www.nlist.inflibnet.ac.in. These Databases provide online access of the electronic resources to the members, teachers as well as students and research scholars. Readers have been allowed an open access to the library holdings. For smooth functioning of the library, the books cases are divided into sections, according to the streams.

Library is well stocked with reference books, journals, magazines, news-papers, and e-resources. It provides assistance to its users ranging from location of a book to finding specific information required. It also has a “Book Bank Section” which holds multiple copies of selected textbooks for making them available to the meritorious and needy students for the entire session.

Library resources are regularly updated with an aim to provide an access to the latest quality resources for teaching, research and study. Total number of books purchased this year as per Accessing Register till date is 325 and the annual expenditure of purchase of books/e-books and subscription to journals/e- journals during this year is around 1 lakh.

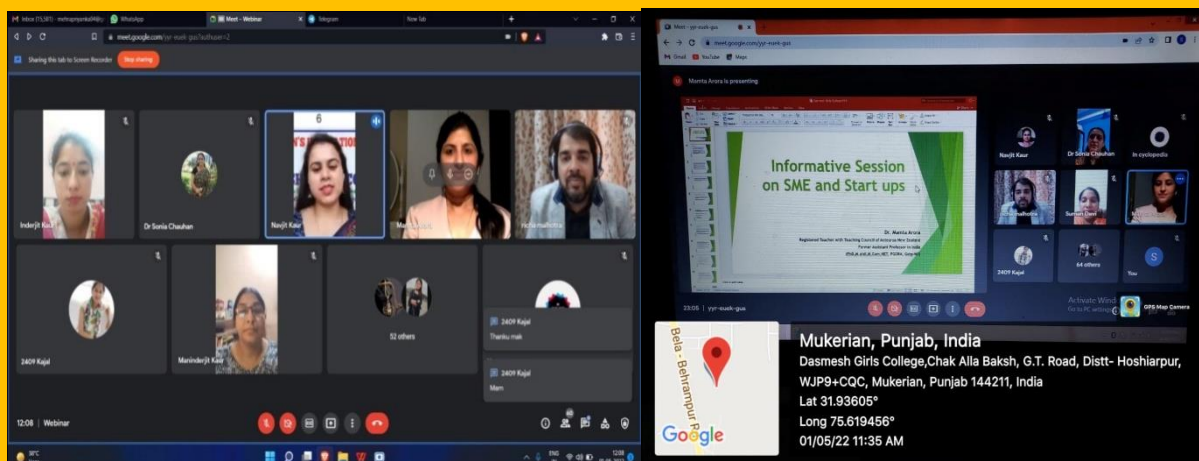

International Lecture Organized

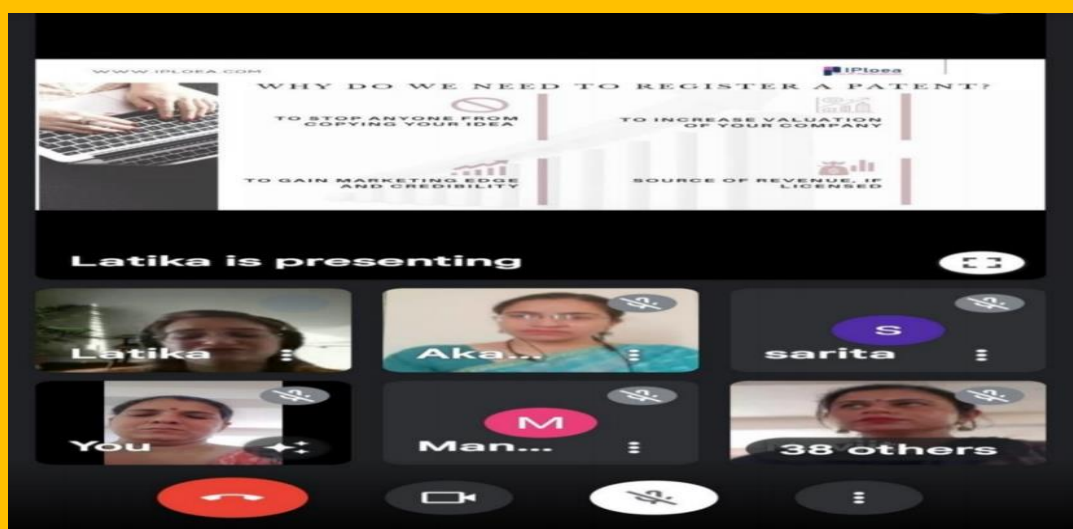

Department of Science

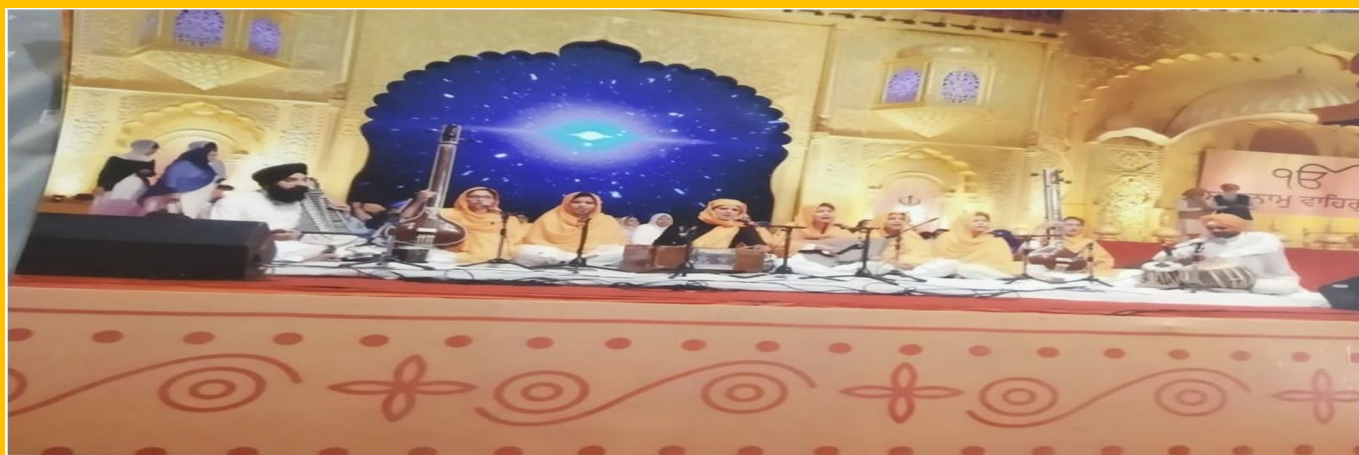
