Dasmesh Girls College Chak Alla Baksh, Mukerian, established in 2001 and got affiliation in 2006 from the Panjab University, Chandigarh vide affiliation No Misc/A-4/1917 dated 31/3/2010. c. Both of the the parties of this MOU represents, warrants and undertakes that :

- i It is duly organized and validly existing under the laws of the jurisdiction in which it is established.
- ii It has the requisite power and authority to execute, deliver and perform this MOU has been duly and validly authorized powers and delivered by it.
- iii Its obligations hereunder constitute legal, valid, binding and enforceable obligations; and

- iv The execution and delivery of this MOU and the consummation/perfection/ completion of the transactions contemplated herein do not breach its organizational documents or any law, provisions of any contract or order of court applicable to it and do not require any applicable governmental approval; and
  - v The persons executing this MOU are duly authorized to execute the MOU for and on behalf of the respective Party and shall have the authority to bind the respective Party accordingly.
  - vi this MOU constitutes a legally valid and binding obligations in accordance with the terms hereof;
- d The Second Party is intended to facilitate a collaborative program of research training, curriculum, institutional development, information dissemination, and exchange of faculty, students and staff of its campus. The linkage hereby formed shall further strengthen each partner institution's objectives as well as the mutual relationship between the partners. The First Party is interested to provide its training, development and consultancy of various types of technologies to the students of campus of the second party. Both the parties with the common interest have mutually determined its covenants.

Now, both the parties have concluded in writing as under after consideration of mutual promises and declarations in the form of MOU as under:

#### **CLAUSE 1 : CO-OPERATION**

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institute and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 Both the parties will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of Institute providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

## CLAUSE 2 : SCOPE OF THE MOU

The MOU is intended to outline the general framework for collaboration between the parties. Initial goal is to outline and describe certain respective goals, strategies and objectives, as the case may be and establish a mutually beneficial relationship. Following are the areas for mutual collaboration and support:

- 2.1 Up-gradation of Labs/Infrastructure: The First Party will provide all necessary guidance & support for the up-gradation of existing labs and infrastructure as per the latest requirements.
- 2.2 Consultancy Projects: Both Parties have agreed to work on the Consultancy Projects to be carried out for the field companies/Industries in Biotechnology.
- 2.3 Industrial Training & Visits: Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into the latest developments/requirements of the industries. The first party will arrange the visit for the Faculty and Students of the second party in its group companies and also involve in Training Programs. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The first party will provide Development Centre/Labs/Workshops/Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the students enrolled with the second party.
- 2.4 Internships and Placement of students. The first party will actively engage to help the delivery of the Internship and Placement of students of the second party.
- 2.5 Research and Development. Both Parties have agreed to carry out joint research activities in the related fields.
- 2.6 Skill Development Programs. The first party will support for conducting skill development program as per NSQF standards for the students of second party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 2.7 Expert/Guest Lectures: The first party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures by Industry Experts to the students of the second party on technology trends and in-house requirements.
- 2.8 Faculty Development Programs: The first party to train the Faculties of second party for imparting industrial exposure/training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 2.9 Assessment and Certification: The first party will do necessary Assessment & Certification for the various training programs in the emerging field in its preview.



- 2.10 Use of infrastructure: It is agreed upon that the first party, may use the infrastructural facilities of second party like Conference room (for meetings, seminars & educational trainings) and Library facilities for its members subject to the availability at that time.

### CLAUSE 3: OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 3.1 Entire MOU. This MOU, constitutes the entire MOU and understanding between the Parties and supersedes any previous MOU or understanding or promise between the Parties, relating to the subject matter of this MOU. All schedules, Recitals and Annexure to this MOU shall be an integral part of this MOU and will be in full force and effect as though they were expressly set out in the body of this MOU.
- 3.2 Amendment/Modification/Variation- The parties agree to meet, discuss and endeavour to negotiate, in good of faith, any changes, planned, projected, wished for, anticipated and proposed by either of the party. Any changes mutually settled and agreed will be reduced in writing and signed jointly/reciprocally by the parties to this MOU, for and on behalf of each party otherwise no plea of any modification, addition, deletion or alteration in the terms and conditions of this MOU shall be entertained.
- 3.3 Severability/dissolution/Invalidity or unenforceability-if any provision of this MOU is held to be illegal or invalid under present or future laws or regulations effective and applicable during the term of this MOU, such provision shall be fully severable/unenforceable and the remaining provisions of this MOU shall remain in full force and effect. Invalidity or unenforceability of any one or more of the provisions of this MOU shall not invalidate or render unenforceable the remaining provisions of this MOU.
- 3.4 Force Majeure-The obligations of the parties to the MOU will be suspended when either party is subject to Force Majeure as per Law of the land which may be termed as civil disturbance, tempest (violent storm), acts of God, emergency status etc.
- 3.5 Confidentiality – The Parties to the MOU shall take all reasonable precautions not to disclose, divulge and/or disseminate to any third party any confidential information and/or business of the Society. This obligation will not apply to information for which the parties might be required to disclose under applicable law or by order of competent judicial or government authority.
- 3.6 Safety and security –That each Party shall comply with standards and policies of safety and security as applicable and in force from time to time.

- 3.7 Compliance of Acts/Rules & Regulations- Both parties shall be responsible to comply with their respective specifications or obligations or requirements or rules prescribed by the government or relevant authority as applicable to them under this MOU.
- 3.8 Assignment/transfer of MOU- That the parties to this MOU shall not be entitled to assign or transfer or otherwise part with this MOU or any rights or interest for any person at his own and without the prior written consent of each other. Nothing in this MOU, whether express or implied, is intended to confer any rights or remedies under or by reason of this MOU on any persons other than the Parties to it and their respective successors and assigns, nor is anything in this MOU intended to relieve or discharge the obligation or liability of any third persons to any Party to this MOU, nor shall any provisions give any third persons any right of subrogation or action over and against any Party to this MOU
- 3.9 Relationship status of the Parties – That the relation between the parties shall be on principal to principal basis. Any of the parties shall not work as an agent or representative of the other party and/or any of his workers//employees will not make any representation or promises or shall not create any obligation or liability for and on behalf of the other party.
- 3.10 Intellectual Property Rights- Nothing herein shall grant a Party any right, associate, or interest in the other Party's or its group entity's trademarks and trade names, other than for the purposes of this MOU. At no time during or after the term of this MOU shall a Party challenge or assist others to challenge the other Party's or its group company's trademarks or the registration thereof or attempt to register any trademark, marks or trade names confusingly similar to those of the other party. The respective parties own the rights to their respective work products.
- 3.11 Communication - That any communication and/or notice, required or permitted to be given under this MOU or in connection with it, shall be in writing and shall be deemed to be validly sent and served by any party to the other party of this MOU at the address of the concerned party as first written above in this MOU. Any party hereto may change above stated particulars of address/communication by giving information to the other party in writing.
- 3.12 Non-exclusivity – It is agreed and clarified that this MOU is on a non-exclusive basis and the Parties are at liberty to enter into similar MOUs with others.
- 3.13 Binding : This MoU shall be binding upon and shall ensure for the benefit and interest of both the parties.

3.14 Survival of provisions- That any provision of this MOU which contemplates performance or observance subsequent to termination or expiration of this MOU shall survive termination or expiration of this MOU and continue in full force and effect.

**CLAUSE 4: TERM & EXTENSION:**

The Memorandum of understanding will become effective immediately on the date of its execution as first written above. It shall continue in effect for a period of One year from the date of its execution. It may be amended and/or extended by mutual written consents of the parties.

**CLAUSE: TERMINATION & CONSEQUENCES OF TERMINATION**

5.1 Termination: This MOU may be terminated on its expiry or by mutual consent of parties or insolvency of any party within the meaning of law or voluntary/compulsory liquidation of any party or prohibition of any party by any regulatory or statutory restriction from continuing to perform its activities related to this MOU or by either party through written notice by any party, upon breach or noncompliance/violation of terms and conditions of this MOU by the other party , if issues have not been resolved against efforts/warnings/notices or by either party through 60 days prior written notice to the other party.

5.2 Consequences of termination of MOU

a In the event of termination of this MOU, both the parties shall return all the property items including data/information in soft /or hard of other party having in their custody, if any, through proper receipt. None of the parties shall use the properties of the other party, if any, lying in its possession. It will be binding on both the parties to settle their accounts. If any, related to this MOU mutually within a period of 30 days from the date of termination of this MOU otherwise the concerned party shall be responsible and liable of the consequences.

b Except as expressly set forth herein termination or expiration of this MOU shall not serve to terminate or cancel any of the respective rights and obligations of the Parties which arose hereunder during the term of this MOU and which by these terms must remain valid and enforceable to give effect to their meaning, including, without limitation, any intellectual property, warranty, Indemnification, confidentiality, ownership of work product, relationship, liability and governing law and dispute resolution provisions hereof.



## CLAUSE :6 GOVERNING LAW & SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE

That this MOU and any dispute or claim relating to it, its enforceability or its termination is to be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India and/or law of land, In the event of any kind of differences or disputes between the Parties in connection with this MOU, the parties shall first seek to resolve such dispute through negotiation failing which the parties here to shall have the right to take legal remedy through court of law. Both the parties agree that the Courts of Law at Bathinda only shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to entertain any proceeding in respect of any dispute or difference or claim etc. regarding any liability or account of any party arising under this MOU.

Bindings : This MoU shall be binding upon and shall ensure for the benefit and interest of both the parties.


**CLAUSE 7 INTERPRETATION/THIS MOU/ IN THIS MOU**, unless otherwise specified:

- 7.1 Words denoting the singular number include the plural number and vice versa, words denoting the masculine gender include the feminine gender and words denoting persons include companies/ firm/individual/group/ party/ business/government, state or agency of a state, local or municipal authority or government body or any joint venture, association or partnership(whether or not having separate legal personality).
- 7.2 Headings and titles are inserted for convenience only and shall not affect the construction of this MOU.
- 7.3 In case of any ambiguity, or discrepancy between the Clauses and/ or the Annexure(s) to this MOU, the Clauses shall prevail.
- 7.4 Any reference to any MOU deed, instrument, License, code or other documents of any description shall be construed, at the particular time, as a reference to that MOU, deed, instrument, license code or other document as the same may then have been amended, varied, supplemented, modified, suspended or novated/replaced.
- 7.5 Any reference to a day (including within the phrase 'business day' other than Sunday/holiday) shall mean a period of 24 hours running from midnight to midnight under reference to Indian Standard Time.
- 7.6 A reference to any other document referred to in this MOU is a reference to that other document as amended, varied, novated or supplemented at any time.
- 7.7 This MOU may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which, when executed and delivered as an original but all the counterparts taken together shall constitute one document.



Random Sampling of an AC Source using a Capacitor and a DC Voltmeter


Investigations in the Experiment



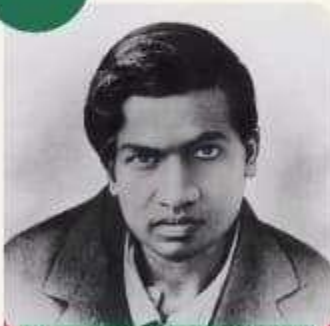

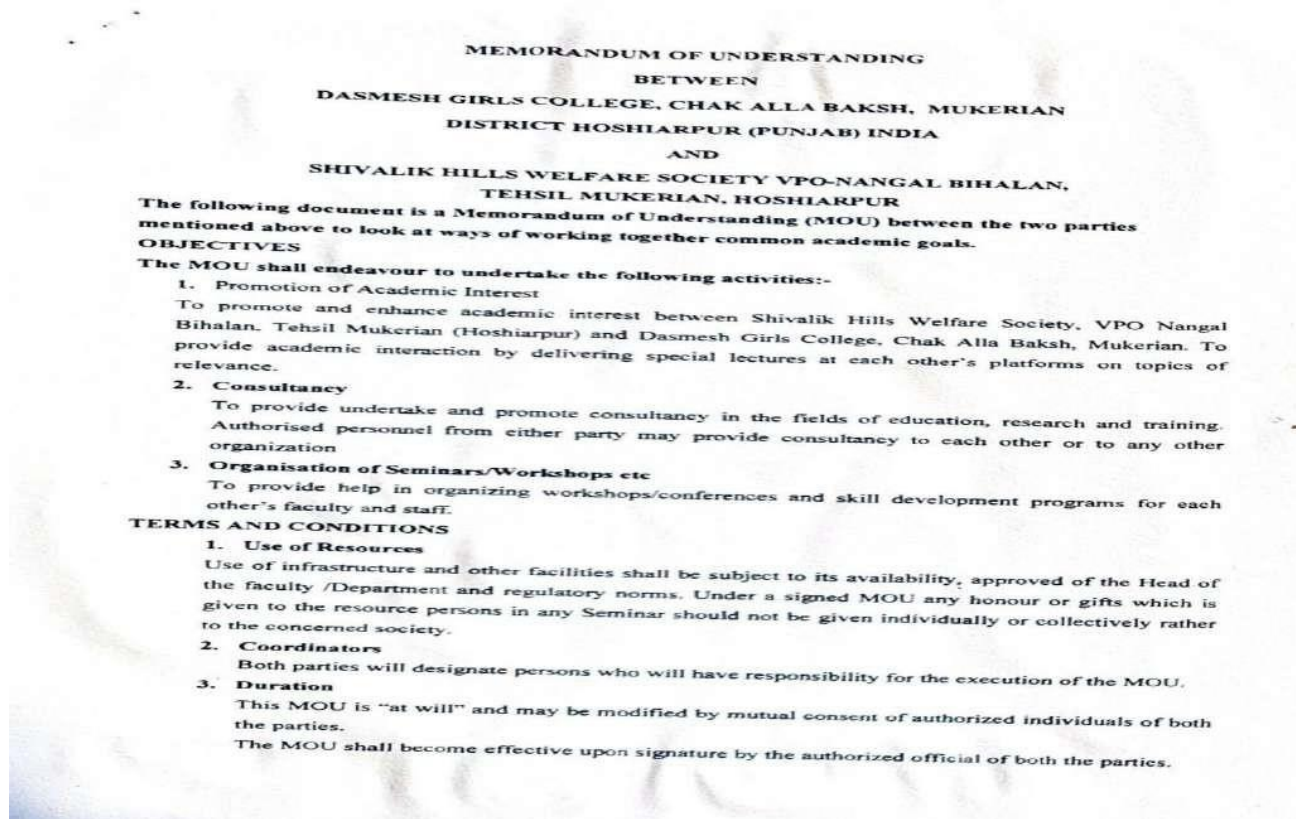

- This MoU and all issues existing out of the same shall be settled in accordance with laws of India.


### Arbitration
