I am a student of DGC. I want to share few suggestions regarding working of the system of DGC.

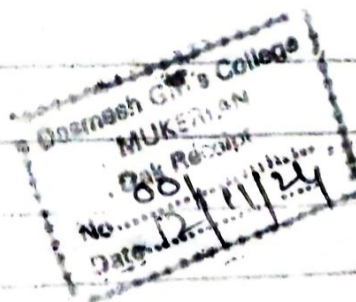

- 3) ✓ Assignments given to students should be more innovative and Exploring for students.

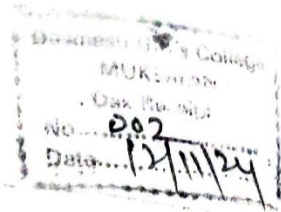
