To provide help in organizing seminar/ workshops/ conferences, skill development programs and to publish research work in ISBN/ISSN no. for each other's faculty and staff.

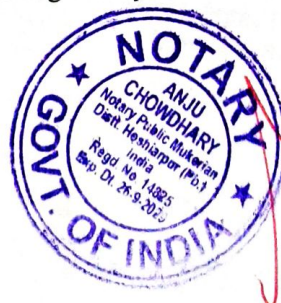
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1 Use Of Resources

Use of infrastructure and other facilities shall be subject to its availability, approved of the Head of the facility/ Department and regulatory norms.

2 Coordinators

The MOU shall become effective upon signature by the authorized officials of both the parties.


This MOU may be amended, renewed and terminated by any of the signing parties at any time.

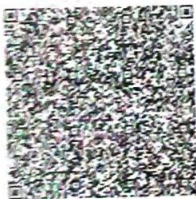
